



Environmental Handling Fees (EHFs) for grain bags
Province: Saskatchewan
Last update: March 1, 2022

As of November 1, 2018, farmers who buy or import grain bags in Saskatchewan started paying a non-refundable Environmental Handling Fee (EHF) at time of purchase to fund a grain bag recycling program. It is based on the weight of the grain bag. The EHF covers the cost of recovering and recycling the plastics into new film products such as industrial garbage bags, construction sheeting and composite dimensional lumber

The EHF is based on the weight and is 22.5 cents per kilogram.
