






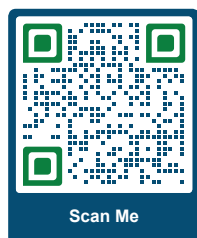
Expanding ag waste recycling options for Prince Edward Island farmers!

Prince Edward Island agricultural producers can drop-off ag waste materials, free of charge at participating collection sites across the province. Our ag-retailer and waste management partners collect and store your ag waste materials; then we arrange for them to be transported for recycling or safe disposal.

Here's what we're collecting

 <p>Containers up to 23L</p>	Commercial pesticide & fertilizer jugs <ul style="list-style-type: none"> empty jugs up to 23L; triple or pressure-rinsed 	Ag-retailer May to October
 <p>Totes & drums</p>	Totes & drums <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 'bulk', non-deposit pesticide and fertilizer totes and drums drained & rinsed (where possible); otherwise ensure no more than 1" of product remains 	Ag-retailer May to October
 <p>Unwanted pesticides & old livestock/equine medications</p>	Unwanted agricultural pesticides & old livestock/equine medications <ul style="list-style-type: none"> unwanted (or "obsolete") commercial pesticides old livestock/equine medications used in agricultural operations 	Ag-retailer (3-year rotation) Fall 2023 & 2026
 <p>Bags & large tote bags</p>	Seed, pesticide, fertilizer* & inoculant bags <ul style="list-style-type: none"> fold bulk bags & tie in bundles of six; place small bags in a collection bag provided free of charge through retailer at point of purchase excludes wood shaving & feed bags <p><small>* A provincially-regulated recovery program for fertilizer bags is now in place in PEI.</small></p>	Ag-retailer or seed dealer May to October *Collection sites for fertilizer bags July & August Bring emptied fertilizer bags tied in bundles of six to one of Island Waste Management Corporation's Waste Watch Drop-off Centers (WWDCs).  <p>Silage plastics (Bale wrap, silage bags and covers, and twine)</p>	Bale wrap, silage plastic & twine <ul style="list-style-type: none"> recycle used silage wrap and twine at IWMC Waste Watch Drop-off Centers (WWDC) keep items as dry as possible and remove excessive mud/dirt; roll up plastic before dropping off 	IWMC collection sites Year-round For Waste Watch Drop-Off Centers for bale wrap, please see bit.ly/3FqalGy OR iwmc.pe.ca
