



Pesticide and fertilizer containers up to 23L

Important

- In Alberta & Manitoba, most municipal collection sites stop accepting containers 23L & smaller by the end of 2024 or earlier. Ask your retailer if they're participating before taking rinsed containers to your local ag retailer for recycling. Contact Cleanfarms with any questions.
- Return containers 23L & smaller in a Cleanfarms collection bag.
- Get free collection bags from your local ag retailer.

1

Rinse

Triple or pressure rinse to ensure no product is wasted.

2

Remove/Bag

Remove paper booklets (and discard), bag containers and tie closed. Ensure seed treatment containers are bagged separately.

3

Return

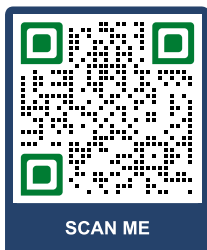
Return properly prepared empty jugs to your municipal collection site or participating ag retailer or seed dealer. Check with your municipal site to ensure they are still collecting these containers.

Remember

- Large acreage farms may be eligible for free on-farm container pickup. Volume requirements apply. Contact Cleanfarms for more information.
- Store unwanted pesticides and old livestock/equine medications safely on farm until the next designated collection event.
